OT010-612, 712 & 812, The Former Prophets: 1&2 Kings (English)

Description	This unit introduces students to the books of 1 & 2 Kings by means of exegesis of the English text. Students will be trained to interpret 1 & 2 Kings, developing their familiarity with the text and its theology and enabling them to exegete passages for themselves.	
Content	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The theology of the Former Prophets, with special reference to 1 & 2 Kings, including motifs such as prophecy, temple, kingship, the kingdom of God, and the Deuteronomistic History. 2. Exegesis of the English text of 1 & 2 Kings, focusing on select passages that are representative of the above theological motifs.
