Description	This unit is a unit in the field of Pastoral and Church Focused Ministry (PC). Preaching is a specialised gift and skill that is recognized as one of the primary modes for presenting the gospel message to Christians and non-Christians. There is a need for pastors and leaders to be able to communicate God's word in Scripture in an accurate, interesting, and relevant way. Introductory Preaching introduces students to the fundamentals of expository preaching and develops their skills in preparing and delivering a sermon.

Methods and techniques of public speaking; contemporary methods in preaching.
