Description	This unit introduces students to the Christian doctrines of the knowledge of God and creation. In other words, it helps them to develop an understanding of how we may know God at all and to rehearse using this theological epistemology in their Christian life, ministry and mission. It then guides them to employ this theological method in order to formulate an understanding of God's work of creating the world and consider what this understanding implies for how they live.
